Dance Party

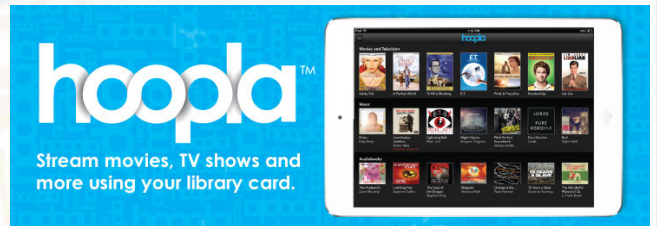
Friday, June 21, 10:30 AM
