**Monday, March 13, 10:00 AM, 12:00 PM, 2:00 PM**

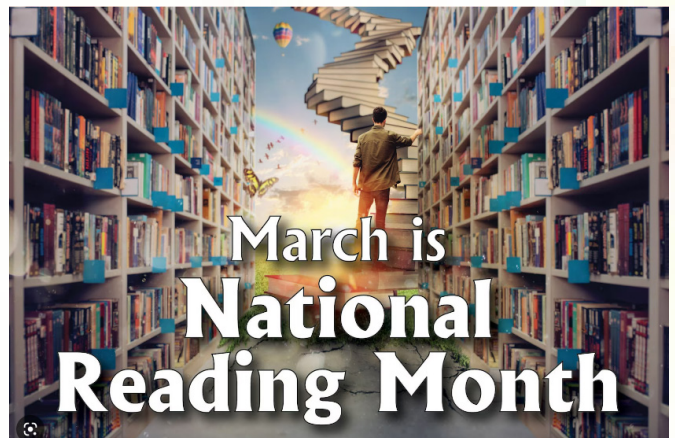
